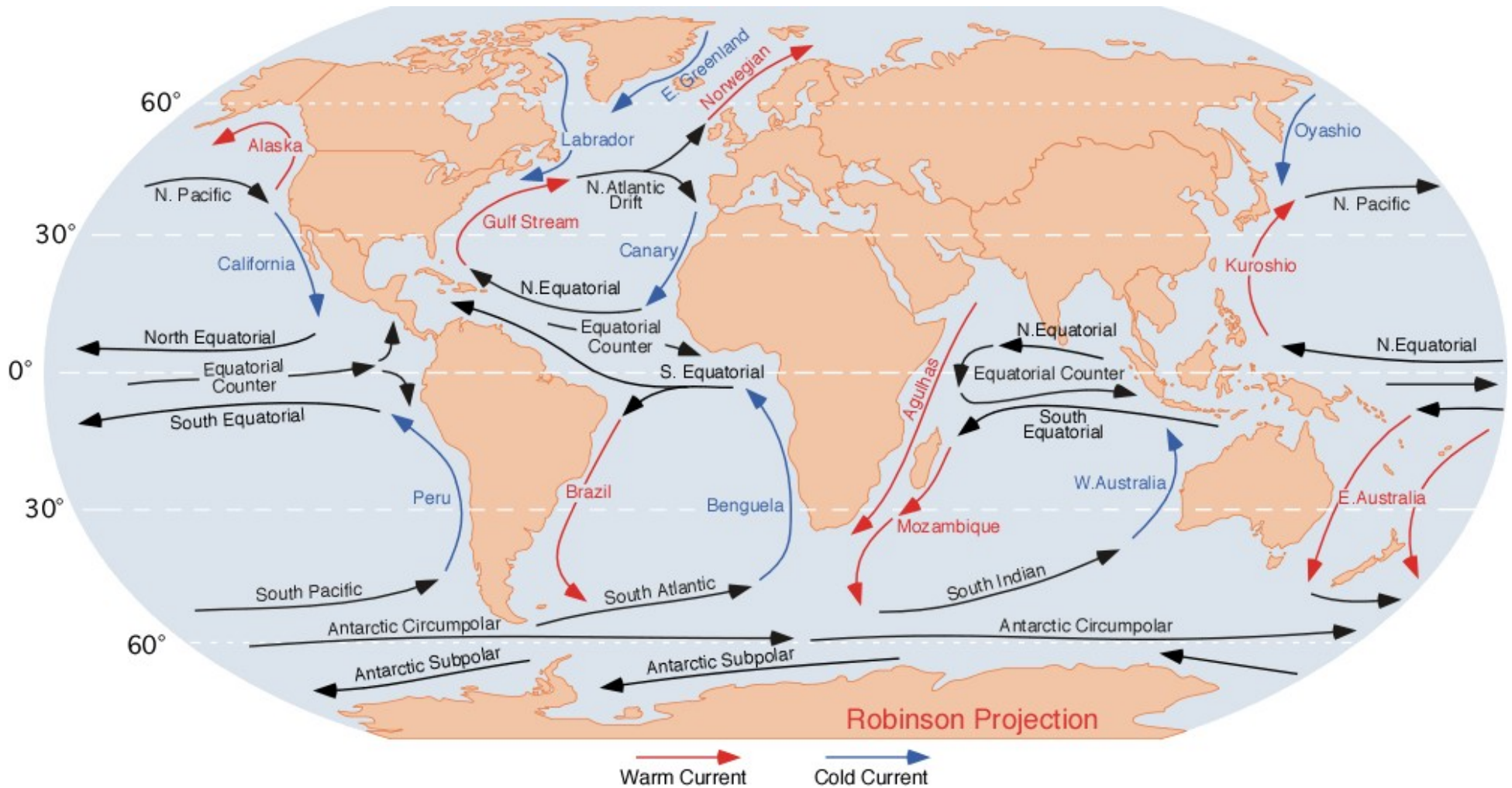
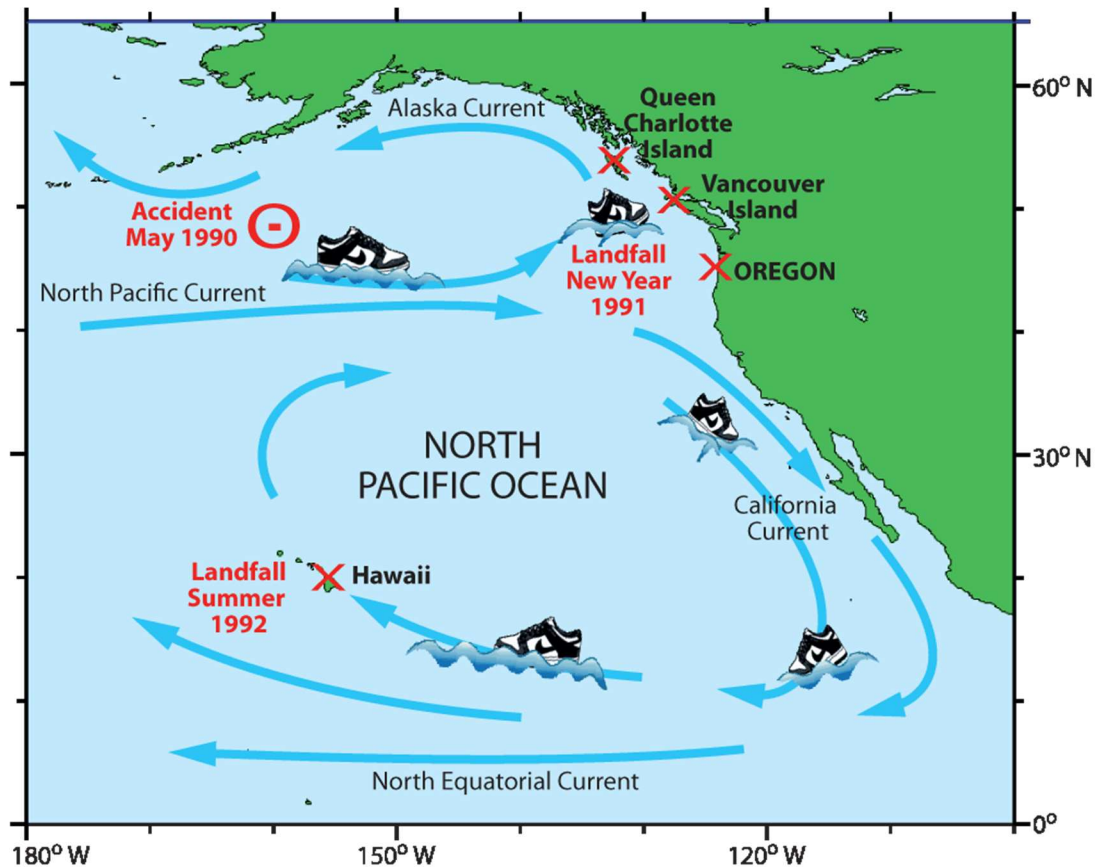


Global Ocean Currents

Facts

- In May 1990 5 containers fell off of a cargo ship releasing 61,000 pairs of Nike shoes into the ocean
- Ocean currents moved the shoes to the shores of Canada, Oregon, and eventually Hawaii
- Our local ocean current, the California Current, brings cool, nutrient dense water down from the North Pacific Ocean and supports our diverse ocean wildlife

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
