- Anchovies

- They have baleen instead of teeth
- They are the more acrobatic whale species with the most varied songs
- They work as a team when hunting; they make a bubble net, trapping fish, they open their big mouths and gulp them whole!

- Open waters
- Alaska to Baja California; Japan to Korea

❖ **Food**

- Bottom dwelling crustaceans
- Schooling fish
- Shrimp
- Worms

❖ **Fun Facts**

- They migrate 10,000 miles each year
- They feed at the bottom by laying on their side and sucking in the sand or mud
- The barnacles are from the lagoon where the whales were born, they stay on them for life!

- Open waters
- Coastal oceans; Arctic and Antarctic waters

❖ **Food**

- Other whales, dolphins
- Seals, sea lions
- Penguins and other birds
- Sea turtles, fishes

❖ **Fun Facts**

- They are very protective of each other; tight knit family groups
- They hunt in packs (up to 50 whales), surrounding their prey and learning new techniques each time
- An orca sleeps with one half of their brain at a time
